

Accessibility - Red Deer Cottage

Red Deer is detached, single storey, all on one level with a south facing terrace that runs along the front of the building.

Access is through a single opening door (820mm) into the kitchen / living room.



There are also doors opening onto the terrace from the living area and main bedroom, however these have a threshold – a ramp can be provided, alternatively access can be gained by using the main access door and taking the path to the terrace.

Internal door widths are 820mm with lever style handles.



There is quality laminate flooring in the kitchen/living room and hall.

The bathroom is tiled and bedroom floor carpeted.

The spacious bathroom is accessed from the hall with tiled floor, electric towel rail and basin with lever style handles taps with clear underspace. The wet room style shower has room for a shower seat (provided) and has a horizontal grab rail on your left. Looking at the toilet there is a horizontal grab rail on the right and a hinged rail on the left. The toilet is raised (500mm) to transfer from the wheelchair to the seat.



In the main bedroom, the 5' bed can be accessed from both sides with space for a wheelchair.



There is also a 13 amp plug near the door so that batteries of motorised wheelchairs can be charged on the outside terrace.

The kitchen has a lower height worktop (900mm) with easy access under the sink. The sink has lever style handles taps.



Please note that the 2nd bedroom (twin) is quite small and does not have a turning circle.

Light switches and sockets contrast to wall colour for visually impaired persons.

There are extra suction rails that can be attached to tiled areas for extra support.
